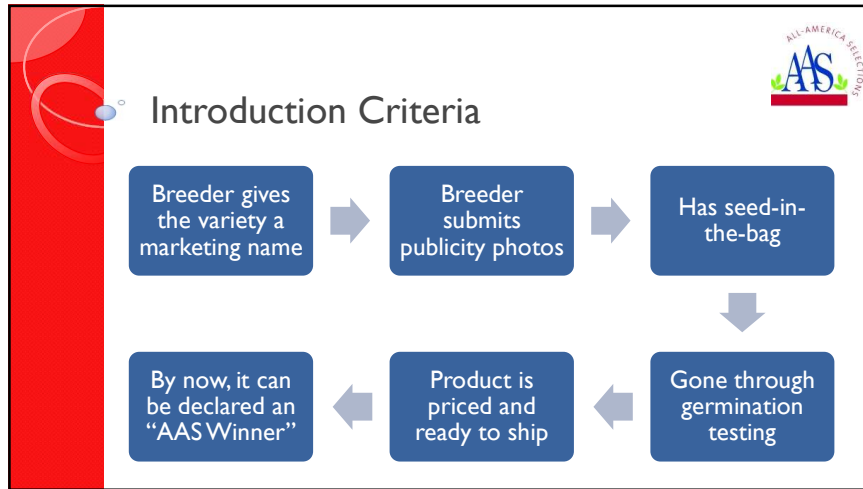
Entries

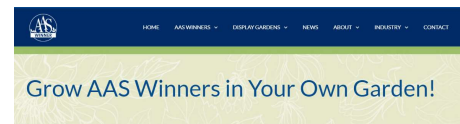

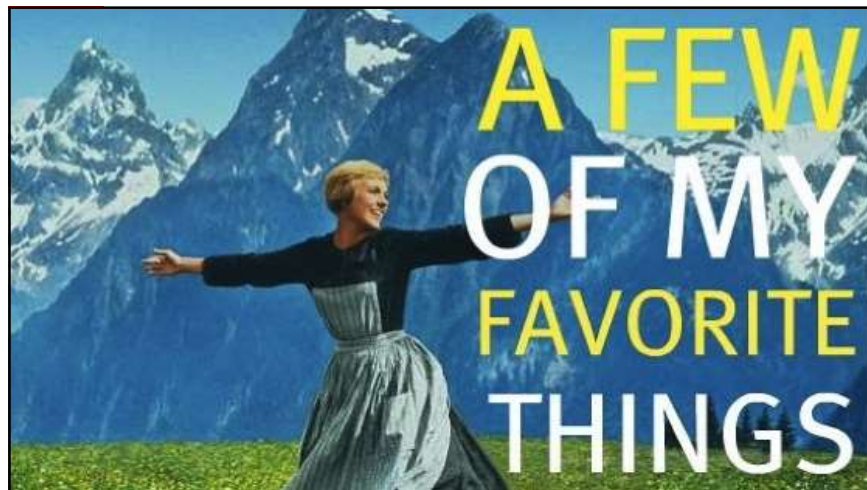

- Daylength neutral
- Large 3" flowers

- Small, single-serving size 1-2 lb. squash
- High yields
